

The primary focus of HGB rehabilitation is to help patients return to normal activity while receiving an exceptional experience. Therapists work one-on-one with patients in EMPOWER at AL!VE, which features state-of-the-art equipment in a pampering environment. Appointments are scheduled within three days of receiving a physician's referral to get the patient on his or her way to better health as quickly as possible.

SPEECH THERAPY

Certified speech language pathologists evaluate and treat deficits involving speech and language, memory and swallowing. Services include:

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Occupational therapists assist patients in regaining, building and developing the skills needed for maximum independence. In addition to orthopedic, work-related or sports-related injuries, patients may be referred for occupational therapy services due to:

- Arthritis, cancer or another debilitating condition
- Developmental disabilities
- Hand or arm trauma
- Stroke or other neurological conditions

Occupational therapy services include:

- Diagnostically specific instruction or education for home exercise programs
- Energy conservation techniques
- Ergonomic instruction

- Instruction in adaptive services/equipment

HGB also has a certified hand therapist on staff to provide more intensive treatment based on patient needs.

VISITING EMPOWER

On the first visit, arrive 15 minutes early to complete medical history forms and provide information or copies of any prescriptions, x-rays or medical reports. HGB accepts most insurance plans. Co-payment is required at the time of service or through an agreed-upon payment plan. Payment can be made with cash, check, Visa or MasterCard.
